-To be an Honorary Envoy, you must-

- 1. Have Ties to Winston-Salem
  - a. Live in Winston-Salem or
  - b. Work in Winston-Salem
  - c. Be FROM Winston-Salem and willing to represent the city.
    - i. Visit Winston-Salem a minimum of once a year.

(Documentation & Verification Required)

- 2. Sign the Agreement
  - a. The Honorary Envoy agreement will last one year from the date of signing.
  - b. You must agree to abide by the code of conduct/ethics, Inclusivity Agreement, Nondisclosure/Confidentiality Agreement and our Mission, Vision, Values.
- 3. Assist the Ambassadors in any way possible with your time and energy, when asked.
- 4. Honorary Envoys will commit to give at least once a year to the WS Ambassadors, to the best of their financial ability.
- 5. Be willing to be contacted about Winston-Salem.
